Purpose of CCA

- A platform for students to discover their interests and talents.
- Progressive development of CCA-specific knowledge, skills, values and attitudes through sustained participation.
- Excellent platforms for student to learn core values, SE competencies and E21CC.
- A common space for friendship integration amongst students of diverse backgrounds.
- Develop a sense of identity and belonging to the school

CCA Participation

- CCA participation is **COMPULSORY** for all students.
- Students stay in the same CCA throughout their secondary school
- At the end of the graduating year, students' co-curricular attainment will be recognised according to Excellent/Good/Fair.
- The level of attainment will be converted to a bonus point(s) which can be used for admission to Junior Colleges/ Polytechnics/ Institutes of Education (JC/Poly/ITE).
- Subjected for approval, students may appeal to another CCA at the beginning of Secondary 2.

CCA Selection (Wk 3: 21- 23 Jan)

- This ensures students can be assigned to a CCA from their five preferred choices.

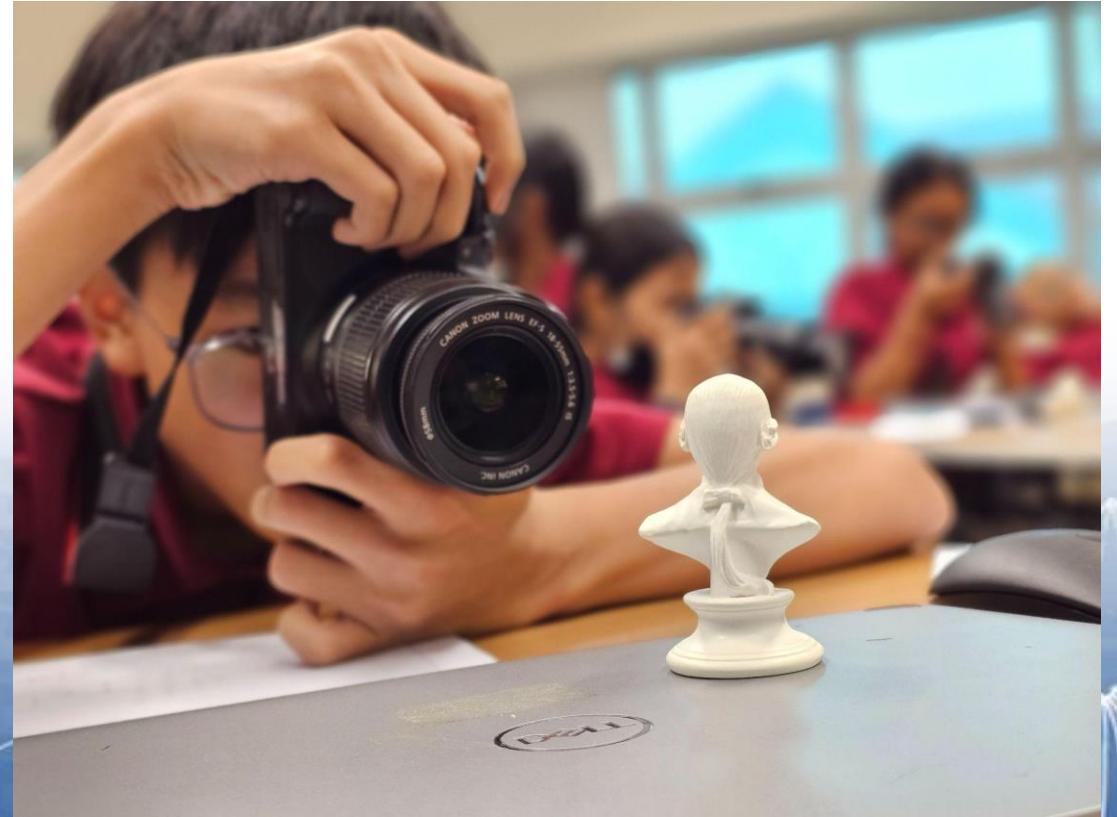
