# Progression Pathways by VP

## PROMOTION CRITERIA FROM SEC. 4N(A) TO SEC. 5N(A)

- Sec. 4N(A) can be promoted to Sec. 5N(A) if you satisfy **ALL** the following criteria:-
  - (a) Obtained an ELMAB3 (EL, Mathematics (MA) and best three other subjects) aggregate score of 19 points or less; **and**
  - (b) Obtained at least an N(A)-Level Grade 5 for all subjects used in the computation of ELMAB3.

- Polytechnic Foundation Programme (PFP)

## TO APPLY FOR DPP,

- a. Sat for GCE N-level Examination in 2020 as a school candidate;
- b. Obtained an ELMAB3 aggregate score of 19 points or less (excluding CCA points); and
- c. Meet subject-specific entry requirements for each course, as stated in

## TO APPLY FOR DPP,

- DPP-eligible students may submit an application online via the DPP application portal

- Successful applicants will be required to attend a 10-week preparatory course prior to commencing their Higher Nitec courses.

## TO APPLY FOR PFP,

4N(A) students may apply for the PFP if they satisfy **all** the following criteria:-

- (a) Sat for their GCE N(A)-Level Examination in 2020 as school candidates;
- (b) Obtained an ELMAB3 aggregate scores of 12 points or less (excluding CCA bonus points)
- (c) Meet the subject-specific entry requirements stated in

<p>Progress to Sec 5N(A) first, even if you meet the PFP eligibility criteria based on your GCE N(A)-Level results in December 2020.</p> <p>You may then apply for the PFP upon release of the GCE O-Level results in January 2021.</p> <p>All PFP-bound students are required to attend Sec 5N(A) classes in their secondary schools up till the last Friday of January 2021, i.e. 29 January 2021.</p>	<p>Apply once you receive your GCE N(A)-Level results in December 2020.</p> <p>Should you accept a DPP offer, you will not be required to return to attend one month of Sec 5N(A)</p>	<p>Progress to Sec 5N(A) first and then apply for both the PFP and DPP upon release of the GCE O-Level examination results in January 2021.</p>

# PROGRESSION TO ITE NITEC

- Students may apply for ITE full-time *Nitec* courses using grades obtained for subjects at the N(T)-Level and N(A)-Level.
- The computation of ITE aggregate points can be found in ITE's Admission Booklet for the January 2021 Joint Intake Exercise.
- Sec 4N(T) students with 0 or 1 N(T)-Level subject pass can enrol in the enhanced *Nitec* Foundation Programme (eNFP), where they will acquire a *Nitec* qualification at the end of three years. The eNFP aims to strengthen students' literacy and numeracy foundations, to help them successfully complete their *Nitec* courses.

# CHECKING OF RESULT SLIPS

- Please check that your personal particulars (such as Statutory Name and Hanyu Pinyin name) are printed correctly on your result slips as the same personal particulars will be printed on your certificates.
- If there is any error, please highlight to your respective form teacher by **18 December 2020 (12noon)**.
- Candidates may request for a re-print of their certificate only if their name were printed wrongly due to misspelling. There will be an amendment fee of \$50 for each certificate that requires a re-print.

# APPEAL TO REVIEW RESULTS

- Students who wish to appeal to review their results are to see Ms Heng at the GO on 18 December or 21 December between 9am – 11am.
- There is payment involved (\$112.35 per subject) and no report will be provided.
- Outcome released in January or February 2021.

- For students who meet the criteria to retain at 4N and wish to repeat 4N,
  - please see Ms Heng at the General Office for the “Request to Repeat Form”
  - “Form” is to be returned to General Office by 22 December 2020 (Monday), 12noon.
